

Dear SPCs,

It's almost time for our conference! Yay! Here is some information you will need as you prepare for your prayer assignments at conference. You will also want to bring the attached documents with you to the conference.

There are four documents attached. Please try to open them to be sure you can get the information. If you have trouble viewing these documents, please let me or Sandra know. Please go over each one carefully and ask questions if something is not clear.

1. SPC Schedule
2. Prayer Watch Assignments
3. Prayer Shield Assignments
4. SPC Abbreviated Schedule

Make special note of the schedules for the Prayer Blitzes, the Prayer Shield, and the Prayer Watch. These are your prayer assignments for conference so you won't want to miss anything.

Thursday 3-5 PM Daytona Room, third floor

We will have a pre-conference meeting just for SPCs on Thursday from 3-5. If you have a SAMUEL who would like to attend with you, she/he is welcome. This is not a meeting for Prayer Partners. I will be mindful to let you out in time to have a break before the evening Prayer Blitz. If you want to drop by the SPC Meeting Room (Dayton Room) before 3 PM just to visit with one another, please feel free to do so. I may be in a meeting with our Prayer Shield Captains, but you are welcome to visit with one another. This is our room.

Wristbands

When you arrive for the conference, go to the registration table to pick up your wristband. You should receive a YELLOW wristband which will allow you access into the general sessions, access into general seating and access to sit in the reserved seats for the Prayer Shield. If you receive any color instead of YELLOW, please let me know. Please do not debate with the people handing out wristbands - just graciously receive what they give you. I will have a list of the names I've submitted for YELLOW bands. Sandra or I will exchange whatever wristband you receive in error for a YELLOW one. Do not request a yellow wristband for a friend, spouse, or Prayer Partner.

YOU MUST HAVE A WRISTBAND to get into the sessions. So, please do not lose your wristband. While they are inconvenient fashion statements, they are quite durable and will hold up through showers and normal wear for the duration of the conference.

SAMUEL Intercessors

SAMUEL is an acronym for See it, Activate it, Model it, Under Excellent Leadership. SAMUELS are younger intercessors who are walking with SPCs in a mentoring relationship during conference. They will have YELLOW wristbands and will be part of all the prayer assignments SPCs have at conference. We have 8 SAMUELS with us this year.

Prayer Partners

You may bring a Prayer Partner to your Prayer Watch assignment. Prayer Partners are not part of the Prayer Shield, therefore, do not require a yellow wristband.

Special Entrance

SPCs who need to get into the auditorium quickly to get to the Prayer Shield may use the front side entrance that designated for those who are going to the green room (backstage) or platform. ONLY those with the platform access wristband or a yellow wristband may use that entrance. Please do not try to bring a friend who does not have a yellow wristband with you through that door. We do not want to cause the ushers any grief.
