- When you are on the Prayer Shield, please be in your seats before the session begins. Your assignment is to pray. Pray for the ministry coming from the platform (Jane, worship team, speakers, offering receivers, prophetic words, etc). Even if prayer is intense, try not to look stern. Give a look of encouragement to those ministering. Pray for the people receiving the ministry there in person and via webcast. Pray for technical and safety aspects.
- There are Prayer Shield Captains: Melody Evans, Judy Garner, Helen Joy Duperree. Sandra Ritter will be roaming to assist. Please follow any directives they give on the Shield.
- If you are not on a Prayer Shield assignment, you may sit anywhere in general seating.
- In General Sessions, all SPCs are part of the prayer ministry team if prayer ministry is directed from the platform.
