Three Days of Preparation

SPCs will take three days prior to the Hosanna Watch beginning to prepare ourselves for this strategic time of prayer. Each day has a particular focus to help prepare us individually and bring us together corporately. Each day, Nancy McDaniel will go on SPC Facebook at 10 AM PAC / 1 PM EST to share a very brief word and prayer. This can be viewed anytime on those days.

• Saturday, September 28 - Repentance

This is personal repentance to present our hearts before the Lord for cleansing so our inner man is prepared to hear the Lord clearly and pray with purity.

Psalm 139:23-24 NKJV Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

Psalm 51:10 TPT *Create a new, clean heart within me. Fill me with pure thoughts and holy desires, ready to please You.*

• Sunday, September 29 - Communion

Have bread and wine available to take communion when you join the SPC Facebook video. Or take communion individually if you cannot join via Facebook. As we take communion, our hearts are turned fully towards the Lord, keeping first things first, and we become One in Him.

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

1 John 1:7 If we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

• Monday, September 30 – Worship and Rest in His Presence

Set your attention on worshiping the Lord and entering His rest. Throughout the month we will engage in numerous forms of intercession, including warfare. War from a place of rest. Stay in His Presence. Let worship be your focus, your peace and your weapon.

Psalm 29:1-2 *Give unto the Lord, O you mighty ones, give unto the Lord glory and strength. Give unto the Lord the glory due to His Name; Worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness.*

Exodus 33:14 And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

Assigned Prayer Times

Most prayer times are one-hour prayer assignments will be at 6 AM in your own time zone. However, to keep assignments fairly even according to Aglow population in each state, many states also have additional prayer assignments at other times of day. All times listed on this schedule are in the time zone indicated. Do not convert these times to other time zones. Some states are located in more than one time zone. Please go with the time zone indicated on this schedule. The states are listed according to Aglow Region. *Please show up on time for your assigned watch* or that time will be uncovered.

Each watch time is one hour unless otherwise specified.

If you or your intercessors would like to join other watch times, you are welcome to do so. Just respect the leader of that watch and flow with the team already on watch. It is wonderful when we support one another.

<u>Prayer Leader for Each Watch</u> – Each SPC is responsible for the Watch on the times scheduled for her/his state. SPCs may ask a mature intercessor in the state to lead a Watch, especially when a state has numerous Watch times. Whether it is the SPC or someone asked to lead, that person is the prayer leader for that Watch time. The Watch leader should:

- Call in a few minutes early so she/he is available to pick up the Watch from the previous team on time.
- Be willing to stay on up to 10 minutes past the assigned Watch time in case the next Watch team is late. If the next Watch team has not come on the line within 10 minutes the Watch leader may leave and report to the Watch Point Team that there is a break in the Watch. If the next Watch leader may leave on time, the previous Watch leader may leave on time.
- Keep the team focused. If someone meanders into a teaching or prayer focuses that are not part of this Watch, the Watch leader brings the team back into focus, even if it means interrupting someone who is heading a different direction. The Watch is not a time for teaching or giving commentary on issues. While a brief sentence or two is sometimes necessary to introduce a prayer focus, keep the Watch focused on prayer. Encourage everyone to participate. Do not allow one person to dominate the prayer time. Some feel their role is to pray quiet prayers of agreement, but all should be given the opportunity to pray on the call as time permits.
- Prayer may include prayers of proclamation, decree or petition all manners of prayer. Praying in the Spirit is also welcomed as tongues is our governmental language. Worship helps keep the team focused on the Majesty of God as we pray. Worship is also a powerful weapon!
- Most importantly, let Holy Spirit lead.
- If the Watch leader is not the SPC, the SPC should share resources, directives, insights and
 inspirations that Nancy McDaniel provides through email, SPC Facebook daily posts or STARS.
 This aids in the corporateness and unity of the Hosanna Watch across the nation. If a non-SPC
 Watch leader has a question or problem, she/he should seek help from the SPC. The SPC may, in
 turn, reach out to a Point of Contact Person.
- If there are any words, scriptures or special insights during a Watch that seem as though they may be for the whole group, the SPC should post those on the SPC Facebook page so we can all benefit from how Holy Spirit is speaking to us.
- A Watch team may consist of as few as the Watch leader and a prayer partner or as many people as call in at that time.
